In particular, the following sentence has been added: "Finally, it is well known that the prevalence of resistant bacteria is different among countries. For this reason, travelling to countries with high prevalence of resistant bacteria was associated with colonization and may be considered a risk factor for developing infective complications after prostate biopsy. However, we have no data about it in the current literature."
