Because it is part of the material and methods section Page 7, introduction section. The aim the study that authors wrote in the end of the introduction section did not match with that of the abstract section. Page 8, Results section, first line. From January 2010 to June 2013. delete this sentence it is redundant because you have included in the material and methods section Pages 4 and 13, abstract and discussion sections. Please check the conclusions in both sections because they did not match.

Answering:

1. Page 7, introduction section, first paragraph, lines 2-4, had been replaced by the objective of the study.
2. Page 8, Results section, first line. From January 2010 to June 2013. this sentence had been deleted.
3. The conclusions had been modified.
