Also, numerous linguistic/stylistic errors should be corrected 'e.g. volunteers, "The diagnosis of GERD has been settled by upper endoscopic" should be changed to "The diagnosis of GERD was established by ... "Exclusion criteria for all subjects were the anamnestic data about: coronary artery disease.....", should be changed to Exclusion criteria were prior history of: coronary artery,..... "During the current study the entire medication has been refrained" should be changed to During the current study patients were asked to stop all medications.
