The main comments of the reviewers are that the manuscript is too long. It has been shortened. I think it could have been shortened further - to limit it to FG associated with rectal cancer. As it stands the manuscript includes all causes of FG, and is probably too broad. I'll leave it up to the managing editor to decide whether it should be shortened further. Otherwise it looks good, and the language seems to have been improved.
