JOURNAL EDITOR-IN-CHIEF (ASSOCIATE EDITOR) COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The paper is interesting and well conceived. Minor comments: In Figure 2 mRNA in-situ hybridization analysis of epithelial-to-mesenchymal transition markers the authors should repeat briefly how the probes were constructed/developed or to refer readers to the text; e.g. the probes were constructed as described in the method section. The manuscript requires careful check spelling and correction of errors; e.g. "circumstance of 37 °C" is not a correct term
