However, the authors discussed mainly about the good progress of hepatic stem cells in the treatment of liver diseases and neglect one of major challenges/obstacles of this treatment, cell resources. It remains very difficult to expand hepatic stem cells in vitro. I feel that the authors should include a paragraph in this review article to discuss the source of the cells. Minor point: in the first sentence of the paragraph prior to the conclusion, it should be 'ensure', not ensue.
