This is a highly interesting and up-to-date review article on a neglected disease of acute kidney injury in patients with chronic liver disease. The review article is well performed concise its content and of high interest for the reader of WJH. Additionally, the presented results will have an important impact on further studies with regard to AKI especially in chronic hepatitis B. The authors have successfully implemented the criticisms and comments raised by the reviewers, and the language meets the requirements for publication. However, there are some minor typing and grammar errors which must finally be corrected. 1. Page 13, first para. The sentence “...in the presence of renal dysfunction, monitoring the aminoglycoside blood level in order to adjust it he dose is helpful to prevent nephrotoxicity” is absolutely not clear, and should be checked carefully and rewritten. 2. Table 2, heading. There is an typing error: it must read proposed instead of “porposed” I consider accepting the manuscript for publication in World Journal of Hepatology after minor revision.
