Unfortunately, this article is not of sufficient interest to our readership to warrant publication. In case report section about treatment, authors described a posterior splint was used for 4 weeks; but in discussion section, authors described a posterior splint was removed 3-4 days after reduction. Which is correct? In Core tip: Sentence "Subtalar dislocations are typically occurs…" needs to be changed as" Subtalar dislocations occur typically …".
