JOURNAL EDITOR-IN-CHIEF (ASSOCIATE EDITOR) COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is a well written manuscript. My recommendation is accept with minor revision. There are two areas that need clarification: on page 5, second line from bottom, the authors stated "He was advised flat foot gait for 6 weeks---", "flat foot gait" is confusing. I recommend use Toe-touch weight bearing. On page 16, figure 1 legend, "--- and tibia showing---" the photos did not show tibia at all. I recommend to remove "and tibia".
