### JOURNAL EDITOR-IN-CHIEF (ASSOCIATE EDITOR) COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is a literature review summarizing current concept of treatment of ESFT. The revised manuscript improved significantly. There continues to have some minor language issues, for example: on page 6: "WHICH ARE THE CLINICALLY RELEVANT PROGNOSTIC FACTORS?" what is a better word to use in this sentence in stead of WHICH; on page 10: "---eradicate ESF tumor tumor cells and timely incorporation ---" tumor is repeated; on page 10, last sentence (and several other places in the manuscript): "---complications, like-post-op---" change "like" to "such as". The authors/editorial office need to correct these and to improve quality of writing before it is published.
