### JOURNAL EDITOR-IN-CHIEF (ASSOCIATE EDITOR) COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

I agree with the overall comments by the reviewers that this is excellent review article about the development and applications of laparoscopic surgery as an important and advanced methodological aspect in clinic. Meanwhile, I also notice there exists a somewhat insufficient commend of standard English, which may impair the readability of this article. For example, the authors used incorrectly the word “qualified” in the title with probably an intention to express “qualitative” as opposed to “quantitative”. Also, similar grammatical or semantical errors can be found elsewhere throughout the text. Therefore, further language editing or revision deems necessary before it can be published.
